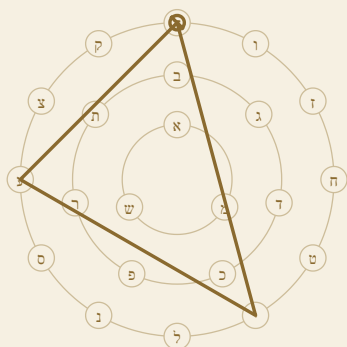

HOW TO CALL HAHAIAH — STEP BY STEP

1. Do the **LBRP** first — clear and protect your space.
2. Face the **sunrise / east**; light a candle if you like.
3. Draw or place the **sigil** before you, and rest your gaze on it.
4. Vibrate the Name softly and slowly, at least three times: **Hahaiah**.
5. Read the **Psalm** below, aloud and unhurried.

6. Speak, in the present tense, what you are aligning with — refuge, revealing hidden mysteries, wise/spiritual persons, dreams. Sit in the presence a while.
7. **Thank** the angel; close by repeating the Qabalistic Cross.

PSALM 10 — IN FULL

- ¹ Why standest thou afar off, O LORD? why hidest thou thyself in times of trouble?
- ² The wicked in his pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken in the devices that they have imagined.
- ³ For the wicked boasteth of his heart's desire, and blesseth the covetous, whom the LORD abhorreth.
- ⁴ The wicked, through the pride of his countenance, will not seek after God: God is not in all his thoughts.
- ⁵ His ways are always grievous; thy judgments are far above out of his sight: as for all his enemies, he puffeth at them.
- ⁶ He hath said in his heart, I shall not be moved: for I shall never be in adversity.
- ⁷ His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue is mischief and vanity.
- ⁸ He sitteth in the lurking places of the villages: in the secret places doth he murder the innocent: his eyes are privily set against the poor.
- ⁹ He lieth in wait secretly as a lion in his den: he lieth in wait to catch the poor: he doth catch the poor, when he draweth him into his net.
- ¹⁰ He croucheth, and humbleth himself, that the poor may fall by his strong ones.
- ¹¹ He hath said in his heart, God hath forgotten: he hideth his face; he will never see it.
- ¹² Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hand: forget not the humble.
- ¹³ Wherefore doth the wicked condemn God? he hath said in his heart, Thou wilt not require it.
- ¹⁴ Thou hast seen it; for thou beholdest mischief and spite, to requite it with thy hand: the poor committeth himself unto thee; thou art the helper of the fatherless.
- ¹⁵ Break thou the arm of the wicked and the evil man: seek out his wickedness till thou find none.
- ¹⁶ The LORD is King for ever and ever: the heathen are perished out of his land.
- ¹⁷ LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:
- ¹⁸ To judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress.

Held honestly. The angel is the **light pole**; each of the 72 pairs with a Goetia spirit (the shadow pole) — worked only with the angel, behind protection, and that is Advanced work. The map is not the verdict: your **own** felt connection is as valid as any table. *The heavens incline; they do not compel.*
