HOW TO CALL MEHIEL — STEP BY STEP

1. Do the **LBRP** first — clear and protect your space.
2. Face the **sunrise / east**; light a candle if you like.
3. Draw or place the **sigil** before you, and rest your gaze on it.
4. Vibrate the Name softly and slowly, at least three times: **Mehiel**.
5. Read the **Psalm** below, aloud and unhurried.

6. Speak, in the present tense, what you are aligning with — protection vs rabid beasts/adversaries; literature, oratory, printing. Sit in the presence a while.
7. **Thank** the angel; close by repeating the Qabalistic Cross.

PSALM 33 — IN FULL

- ¹ Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright.
- ² Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.
- ³ Sing unto him a new song; play skilfully with a loud noise.
- ⁴ For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.
- ⁵ He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.
- ⁶ By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.
- ⁷ He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses.
- ⁸ Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.
- ⁹ For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.
- ¹⁰ The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect.
- ¹¹ The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.
- ¹² Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD; and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance.
- ¹³ The LORD looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men.
- ¹⁴ From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth.
- ¹⁵ He fashioneth their hearts alike; he considereth all their works.
- ¹⁶ There is no king saved by the multitude of an host: a mighty man is not delivered by much strength.
- ¹⁷ An horse is a vain thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength.
- ¹⁸ Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy;
- ¹⁹ To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine.
- ²⁰ Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield.
- ²¹ For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy name.

²² Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.

Held honestly. The angel is the **light pole**; each of the 72 pairs with a Goetia spirit (the shadow pole) — worked only with the angel, behind protection, and that is Advanced work. The map is not the verdict: your **own** felt connection is as valid as any table. *The heavens incline; they do not compel.*
